I would like to offer my perspective on the depth and breadth of skills and knowledge that Rich Fairclough of Perfect Pooch possesses in the area of dog behavior.

I have a fairly extensive background in canine training. In my youth, I was a Military Working Dog handler in the United States Air Force. In my four year enlistment, I handled Patrol Dogs and Narcotics and Explosives Detector Dogs. My last year on active duty I was the training NCO for the Military Working Dog Section at my base. After I separated from the Air Force, I was hired as a dog handler and trainer for a Sheriff's Department, where I trained K-9 teams for several police agencies.
